## **EXPLANATORY NOTES:-**

- 1.The table is based on the example of 2nd case of Annexure to DOP OM dated 12/5/2017 where pension has been arrived for a retiree of 4th CPC from S 19 (Level 11).
- 2. Row 1 gives the pay on retirement (LPD) in the SAG scale during 4th CPC.
- 3. The notional pay from 4th to 5th CPC (row 4) is fixed as per the Ready Reckoner for Fixation of pay in 5th CPC Scales.
- 4. The notional pay from 5th to 6th CPC (row 5) is fixed in accordance with the Fitment tables issued by MOF (DOE) dated 30.8.2008.
- 5. Notional pay in 7th CPC (row 6) has been fixed with a MF of 2.57 in the same way as for the working employees vide MOF (DOE) RESOLUTION dated 25.7.2016.
- 6. Row 9 gives pension as per option 1 for comparison purposes.
