

Update regarding Benefit of replacement scale of S-12 Rs.6500-10500 with Rs.7450-11500 ie GP 4600 after 6th CPC for fixation of Revised minimum Pension of Pre-2006 Pensioners

> I am happy to inform the concerned Pensioners that the issue of Benefit of Merged / Upgraded Scales for revision of Pension, seems to be coming to the right track now and we can expect the results early atleast in respect of Benefit of replacement of scale Rs.6500-10500 with Rs.7450-11500 ie GP 4600 after 6th CPC for fixation of Revised minimum Pension of Pre-2006 Pensioners.

1. As a follow up of our Memorandum dated 21-5-2018 to MOF with copy to Secretary Pension, I met Shri Harjit Singh Director DOP&PW on 4th July, 2018 and after detailed discussions the following position had merged:

2. The DOPPW had recently sent the case for the fifth time in this year, to MOF DOE for approval of this item for Benefit of replacement scale Rs.6500-10500 with Rs.7450-11500 ie GP 4600 after 6th CPC for fixation of Revised minimum Pension of Pre-2006 Pensioners and now for the first time the DOE has sought the details of Financial implication of the issue.

3. This is a very positive indication and we can expect some ealy results. We should, therefore, stop expressing negatively about the proceedings in this case.

4. However, the case regarding similar benefit to Pensioners who retired from other pay scales which had been replaced by high Pay Scales after 6th CPC, this is sub judice as a SLP has been filed by the Govt in UOI-vs-Rajindra vide Diary no. 20410 /2018 filed on 22-5-2018 against WP(C) 8113/2016 order Dated 14-9-2017.
