

## **Admn to beautify railway residential colony**

For the beautification of the railway residential colony located in Sector 49, the UT Administration is chalking out the plans with the resident welfare association of the society.

A meeting was conducted by the UT Deputy Commissioner (DC) Mohammed Shayin and with the RWA delegation today. In the meeting the DC has asked the residents to prepare the estimates of the beautification works of the society.

Recently, the Union Railway Minister Pawan Kumar Bansal allocated Rs 1 lakh under the MPLAD fund for the beatification works of the good will residential society. After which, the RWA president Harbans Singh had a meeting with the officials to discuss the proposals on which the funds should be utilised by the authorities.

In a meeting, the residents demanded to install benches and hut in the green belt located in the society for which the members were asked to prepare an estimate for the same and table it in next meeting.

Delegation of the society met the Union Railway Minister three months ago and had submitted a memorandum in which a demand to allocate funds for the beautification of society was made by the members.
