Subject: Non issue of Revised PPOs to Pre-2006 Pensioners & Family Pensioners


We extremely regret to bring to your kind notice that Revised PPOs have not so far been issued to a very large majority of Pre-2006 Pensioners & Family Pensioners by the various Departments of Central Government – in spite of clear orders issued in this regard by the DOP (P&PW).

1. All this is leading to serious hardship to Pensioners / Family Pensioners due to major changes brought in the Pension Rules after the Sixth Central Pay Commission. Many of the Pensioners & Family Pensioners are not being paid by the banks - the Additional Pension or the DA on the Additional Pension and in some cases they are not paying even the Revised Pension / Family Pension.
2. a) Ironically, some of the Administrative Offices have advised that the Revised PPOs shall only be issued to those Pensioners / Family Pensioners who had applied for the same, even though orders of DOP (P&PW) cited above, did not lay down any such condition and Revised PPOs were to be issued to all Pensioners / Family Pensioners; and action in this regard was to be initiated suo-moto by the concerned Heads of the Departments.
b) Incidentally, PPOs have not yet been issued even to those Pensioners / Family Pensioners who had applied for the same more than one & a half years back.
3. All this is causing serious & undue hardship to the Pensioners & Family Pensioners as well as anxiety and uncertainty especially about the Additional

Pension after 80 years of age particularly in case of widows – as their age is not recorded in the old PPOs and it is very difficult to get the same admitted by the Banks – especially in this old age with frail health.

4. It is, therefore, requested that - in order to mitigate the present and future hardship of the Pensioners / Family Pensioners – all concerned may please be advised to issue the Revised PPOs to Pre-2006 Pensioners & Family Pensioners suo-moto, at the earliest – irrespective of the fact whether the Pensioners & Family Pensioners had applied for the same or not.
