

## **MINUTES OF AGM RSCWS HELD ON 9-1-2015 AT YWCA, SECTOR 11, CHANDIGARH**

1. Sh. N. P. Mohan presided over the meeting, which was attended by 64 Members.
2. Inaugural address by the President: Sh. N. P. Mohan mentioned the following points in his address:
  - I) Requested to Members to contact their colleagues & friends for membership of RSCWS.
  - II) Need for liberal & regular contributing to SWF (Social Welfare Fund) of RSCWS.
  - III) Delay in grant of revision of pension as per modified parity to pensioners due to unjust continuation of 3 SLPs filed by the Govt in the Supreme Court. Unfortunately hearing of these SLPs had not taken place for a long time as this case was appearing lower down in the cause lists so far.
3. CONDOLENCES & TRIBUTES TO THE DEPARTED MEMBERS: Glowing tributes were paid and two minutes silence was observed in memory of Late Sh. M. S. Batra Chairman & Founder President RSCWS and Late Sh. K. S. Bhandary, Vice President (earlier Treasurer RSCWS) and Late Sh. Sukhdev Singh Joint Secretary RSCWS, for their long and dedicated service to the Society.
4. SEMINAR ON DIET & NUTRITION: A) Meeting started with a Lecture on "DIET & NUTRITION MANAGEMENT IN OLD AGE" by Harleen Bakshi, Clinical Nutritionist, Fortis Med Centre, Chandigarh. *followed by an inter-action with the Members.*  
B) Introduction about Fortis Med Centre, Chandigarh: Ms Rupinder Kaur, In charge Fortis Med Centre, Sector 11, Chandigarh, gave an introduction about the activities of the newly started Centre by Fortis Health Care and the Facilities available therein. While referring to the long association with RSCWS, she informed about the decision of the Fortis Management to offer some special concessions to the Members of RSCWS.

5. REPORT BY SECRETARY GENERAL: Sh. Harchandan Singh Secretary General RSCWS mentioned the following points in his Annual Report for the year 2014:
  - i) Brief details of the Memorandum submitted by RSCWS to Seventh Pay Commission;
  - ii) Adverse judgement by Hon'ble CAT Chandigarh in the case filed by RSCWS for higher FMA (of Rs.2000/- P.M.) and possibilities of filling an appeal about it in the High Court;
  - iii) Representation by RSCWS to the Government on various problems of the Pensioners – including Memorandum to MOS (Personnel & Pension) for withdrawing the SLPs filed by Government in Supreme Court against judgement of Hon'ble CAT/ New Delhi for grant of Modified Parity to Pre 2006 Pensioners from 1-1-2006 – keeping in view the Rejection of a similar SLP, Review as well as Curative Petition thereon by Apex Court.
  - iv) Identification of RSCWS and Grant in Aid to RSCWS by DOP (P&PW) for Rs.75000/-
  - v) Launch of Social Welfare Activities Social Welfare Fund (SWF) by RSCWS during the year;
  - vi) Donation of Rs.15000/- to Prime Ministers Relief Fund for Floods in J&K
  - vii) Donation of Rs.15000/- to organisations (NGOs) helping the poor, the needy, elderly and the destitute.
  - viii) Representations to Railway administration on the Medical Problems of Railway Beneficiaries at Chandigarh; and for issuing of Revised PPOs to all Pensioners.
6. BALANCESHEET OF ACCOUNTS OF RSCWS: Balance sheet of Accounts of RSCWS for the year 2014 was distributed to Members, read out and passed unanimously.
7. A) GOLDEN AGE (OCTANIGERIAN) AWARDEES: Following Members were given Golden Age Awards:  
Gurcharan Singh, Harbans Singh, Hukam Chand Goel, Man Singh Sethi, N.P. Mohan, Om Parkash Madan, Prabh Kirpal Singh, Shanti Parkash Khanna & V. K. Sharma.
- B) SENIOR CITIZENS' AWARDEES: Following Members were given Senior Citizens Award: Gurdeep Singh & Khem Singh.
8. AID TO NEEDY NGOs: Two NGOs namely Prabh Asra Ashram and World Peace Organisation" were presented with cheques for Rs.10,000 and Rs.5000 respectively from the Social Welfare Fund (SWF) of RSCWS as aid for upbringing and education of the poor, destitute and the needy children. Two Cartons full of children clothes & Toys were also donated by Smt & Sh. OS Dogra and given to the above two NGOs.
9. ELECTIONS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: Bi-annual election of RSCWS was then held and the list of those elected is placed herewith (See Page 3 of this issue of PRS).
10. CONSIDERATION OF FILING OF APPEAL IN HC FOR HIGHER FMA: it was decided that a Committee be formed by the Executive Committee RSCWS to take legal opinion on the issue and then take action accordingly – in consultation with the President RSCWS.
11. Meeting dispersed after a vote of thanks to the chair and to Fortis Health Care.
