

**7) MODE OF PAYMENT FOR TREATMENT OF BENEFICIARIES**



There shall be three classes of patients:

- I. Railway beneficiaries referred by Railway Hospitals to the empanelled hospital.
- II. Railway beneficiaries reporting to Hospital directly in emergency.
- III. Railway beneficiaries directly reporting to empanelled hospital without any emergency or referral letter and paying on their own for OPD/IPD/investigations for which empanelled hospital shall charge CGHS rate of hospital rate whichever is less.
- IV. RELHS beneficiaries aged 75 years and above (having valid UMID cards and not getting FMA) seeking direct OPD consultation (not including issue of medicines) from specialists of Private Hospitals empanelled by Railway, without referral from Railway Hospital/ Health Unit, which beneficiary is registered.

Railway beneficiaries coming under serial no. 7(I) emergency will be attending the hospital with referral from Railways, the bill should be submitted to the office of the concerned Railway Hospital with whom they have the MOU.

Railway beneficiaries coming under serial no. 7(II) above- emergency as in Para 4 treatment procedures the services shall be undertaken and provided on credit. No payment shall be sought from them and information sent to Railway Hospital through mutually agreed means and authorization be sought from the concerned hospital with whom they have MOU. Situation may arise where railway hospital after scrutinizing admission report submitted by empanelled hospital, find that the patient is not suffering from an emergency. In such cases, the hospitals bills upto the stage of such determination (Para no. 4) shall be paid by Railway directly to hospital. However, the patient can continue to avail treatment at the empanelled hospital, if so desired, paying CGHS rates or hospital rates whichever is less on the patients cost thereafter.

For Railway patients coming under serial no. 7 (III) above empanelled hospital has to collect payment from the Railway patients directly at the rate as decided already. That is empanelled hospitals will provide the necessary treatment in OPD or otherwise to Railway beneficiary at the CGHS approved rates or hospital rates, whichever is less for the treatment in non-referral/ non-emergency case at railway medical beneficiary's own cost.

For Railway patients coming under Serial No. 7(IV), this facility will be subject to the following:-

- (a) This facility will be available for only those aged 75 years & above RELHS beneficiaries (having valid UMID card) who are eligible for OPD consultation at Railway Hospitals/Health Units. This facility is not available to beneficiaries having UMID card with FMA.
- (b) If any CGHS listed investigation/procedures is advised by the treating doctor at railway empanelled hospital and is required to be undertaken in emergency, no other authorization will be required, and the same may be undertaken from empanelled hospital at CGHS rates for that city or as per MOU with Railway in cashless procedure.

Situation may arise where railway hospital, after scrutinizing admission report submitted by empanelled hospital, find that the patient is not suffering from an emergency. In such cases, the hospitals bills upto the stage of such determination (Para no. 4) shall be paid by Railway directly to hospital. However, the patient can continue to avail treatment at the empanelled hospital, if so desired, paying CGHS rates or hospital rates whichever is less on the patients cost thereafter.

For Railway patients coming under serial no. 7 (III) above empanelled hospital has to collect payment from the Railway patients directly at the rate as decided already. That is empanelled hospitals will provide the necessary treatment in OPD or otherwise to Railway beneficiary at the CGHS approved rates or hospital rates, whichever is less for the treatment in non-referral/ non-emergency case at railway medical beneficiary's own cost.







This Addendum of MOU is made on the 21 day of 11-2023 between the President of India acting through Chief Medical Superintendent of India having its office at NRDH/Ambala (Hereinafter called Railway which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of **First Part**.

**AND**

ROTARY AMBALA CANCER & GENERAL HOSPITAL, OPP DUSHERA GROUND, MILL ROAD, AMBALA  
of the Second Part.

Provision of OPD consultation & related investigation for RELHS beneficiaries aged 75 Years & above from specialist of Private Hospital empanelled by Railway as a PILOT PROJECT FOR ONE YEAR FROM 01.11.2023 TO 31.10.2024.

(i) RELHS beneficiaries aged 75 years and above are may permitted to seek direct OPD Consultation from specialists of private Hospital empanelled with NRDH without referral from Northern Railway Divisional Hospital/Health Unit under which beneficiary is registered.

(ii) If any CGHS listed investigations/procedures is advised and is required to be undertaken in emergency no other authorization will be required, and the same may be undertaken from empanelled hospital at CGHS rates for that city/or as per MOU with Railway in cashless procedure. Bills along with copy of UMID card, copy of prescription, reports and declaration form (copy enclosed) signed by the beneficiary and duly endorsed by the competent authority of the empanelled hospital will be sent to Northern Railway Divisional Hospital, Ambala for payment, for only those patients who are beneficiary of Health Units under jurisdiction of NRDH.

(iii) In non-emergency cases, approval of Chief Medical Superintendent Northern Railway Divisional Hospital, Ambala will be required for undertaking (a) Non-CGHS listed investigations/ planned procedures and (b) those CGHS listed investigations, which cost above Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand), whenever advised by specialist of empanelled hospitals.

(iv) Medicines prescribed by a specialist doctor of Railway empanelled private hospitals will be issued by concerned Railway hospitals/Health Units on authorization of available Railway doctor. All Private Empanelled Hospitals doctors are instructed to prescribe medicine by generic name only to Railway beneficiary.

(v) Private Hospitals empanelled under NRDH shall provide above facilities on cashless basis at CGHS rates to Railway beneficiaries aged more than 75 years. The Private empanelled hospitals shall submit the bills along with valid UMID card and declaration form signed by the beneficiary who has availed the facilities, duly endorsed by the competent authority of the Private empanelled hospital.

(vi) This facility will be available for only those aged 75 years & above RELHS beneficiaries who are eligible for OPD consultation at Railway Hospitals/Health Units. This facility is not available to beneficiaries having UMID card with FMA (Fixed Medical Allowance).
